2023 COMMUTING PATTERNS WORKERS AT THREE LARGE SEWARD, NEBRASKA EMPLOYERS

This study provides information on the 2023 Nebraska residence counties and communities (places) for 1,047 workers at three large Seward employers. Concordia University, Hughes Brothers, Inc., and Tenneco Automotive-Walker provided the mailing zip codes for each of their employees as of April 2023. In addition to the 1,047 employees with residences in Nebraska, there were several employees with residences outside Nebraska.

As shown in Figure One and Tables One and Two, the 1,047 workers have residences in 18 Nebraska counties. Seward County is the residence of 507 (48.4%) of the 1,047 workers. Other counties with large numbers of workers commuting to the City of Seward to work at the three employer sites include Lancaster (332 or 31.7%), Saline (92 or 8.8%), and Butler (59 or 5.6%).




FIGURE ONE Number of Workers by Residence Counties for Three Large Seward, Nebraska Employers, 2023

Table Two provides information on the 2021 population of the 18 Nebraska counties where workers at the three Seward employers reside. The 2021 total estimated population of the 18 counties is 1,353,959 people. Douglas County with 578,771 people and Lancaster County with 320,301 people accounted for 42.8 and 23.7 percent, respectively, of the total population of the 18 counties. With a population of 17,605, Seward County accounted for 1.3 percent of the total population.

As shown in Tables Three and Four and Figure Two, the 1,047 workers have residences in 48 Nebraska places. The City of Seward is the residence of 360, 34.4 percent, of the 1,047 workers. Other places with large numbers of workers commuting to the City of Seward to work at the three employers' sites include Lincoln, 324 or 30.9 percent; Crete, 55 or 5.3 percent; Milford, 36 or 3.4 percent; Dwight, 26 or 2.5 percent, Utica, 25 or 2.4 percent; and York, 22 or 2.1 percent.




FIGURE TWO Number of Workers by Residence Places for Three Large Seward, Nebraska Employers, 2023

Table Four provides information on the 2021 population of the 48 incorporated providing workers to the three City of Seward employers. The 2021 total estimated population of the 48 incorporated places is 938,023 people. Omaha with 466,059 people and Lincoln with 289,136 people accounted for 52.0 and 30.8 percent respectively of the total population of the 48 incorporated places. With a population of 7,651, City of Seward accounted for 0.8 percent of the total population.

As shown in Figure Three and Four, 45.6 percent of the workers live within a 15-mile radius of the City of Seward and 95.7 percent live within a 30-mile radius. The longest commute, approximately 115 miles, was from Greeley in Greeley County.

Distribution of Workers' Residences for Three Large Seward, Nebraska Employers by Driving Distance to the City of Seward, 2023





FIGURE FOUR Distribution of Workers' Residences for Three Large Seward, Nebraska Employers by Driving Distance to the City of Seward, 2023



As shown in Figure Five and Six, 44.4 percent of the workers live within a 15-minute drive radius of the City of Seward, and 93.6 percent live within a 30-minute drive radius. The longest commute, approximately 111 minutes, was from Greeley in Greeley County.

FIGURE FIVE Distribution of Workers' Residences for Three Large Seward, Nebraska Employers by Drive Time to the City of Seward, 2023




FIGURE SIX Distribution of Workers' Residences for Three Large Seward, Nebraska Employers by Drive Time to the City of Seward, 2023
