QUALITY GROWTH

- Secured \$1.26 million for the Seward County Rural Workforce Housing Fund
- \$18+ million secured for wellness center that will serve City of Seward and surrounding area
- Launched Seward County Broadband Task Force to identify unserved and underserved parts of the county and align resources to solve connectivity challenges

WELCOMING COUNTY

- Launched Talk Seward County Podcast which highlights happenings, new events, businesses, and more
- Started the Seward County Stories series talking to young professionals across the county
- SCCDP continued a strong relationship with the Seward Newcomers group to welcome new residents

WORKFORCE RECRUITMENT AND SUPPORT

- Created 13 Seward County Career Experience videos in conjunction with the ReVISION grant and in partnership with Seward Public Schools
- Hosted career fairs with local high schools across the county
- Selected to be a member of the Communities for Kids initiative which will help provide resources and funds to support local child care service providers that enable parents to confidently go to work
